



IACME Style: Guidelines for Posters

In the case of Posters: a two-page text must be prepared following the format guidelines of *IACME Style* for all types of presentations.

The only difference in relation to the other forms of presentation is that an Abstract should not be included (since only two pages are available). This text will be published on the event platform.

For the design of the Poster, see the guidelines that follow. A template for this design can be downloaded from the event website.

Design of the Poster

To make the poster, you can use a presentation program (MS Power Point or similar), and print it on paper. You can also do it directly on paper.

The dimensions of the paper to be used must be 90 cm wide by 100 cm up to a maximum of 150 cm high. Only those dimensions will be accepted.

The poster should have 3 cm margins on all sides.

At the bottom you must leave a strip of 10 cm in height to place (at the far right) the information related to the authors: title of the presentation, authors, institutions, country.

The title of the work should be clearly visible and 3 cm in height, in capital letters, in bold and without underlining.

Below the title in uppercase and lowercase letters and without indentation, the name of the authors, without titles or other additions, and in the following lines their email address, institution, website, country.

You must also place (at the far left) of that strip the IACME conference logo, which you must download from the website of this event. A representation of the dimensions and layout of the poster is provided below.

Light background colors should be used, as well as an appropriate font size (for example 48 in Times New Roman). Very small letters do not read well. The idea is that the entire poster can be clearly read from a distance of one meter.
